The books of which I'm lead author are *Irreducible Mind: Toward a Psychology for the 20th Century* (2015); *Beyond Physicalism: Toward Reconciliation of Science and Spirituality* (2015); and *Consciousness Unbound: Liberating Mind from the Tyranny of Materialism* (2021); all published by Rowman & Littlefield.

The one by Phillip Goff that's drawn a lot of critical attention, and where he describes his own confidence about fresh winds blowing in metaphysics and philosophy of mind is *Galileo's Error*.

The recent book by Tim Eastman proposing an alternative way of expanding science is *Untying the Gordian Knot: Process, Reality, and Context*, published by Lexington Books in 2020. He provides lots of pointers into the very active world of contemporary Whitehead scholarship, of which he is a prominent member.
